Journal Presentation

Assignment Overview

The purpose of the Journal Presentation is to have students explore professional literature in the alternative dispute resolution field, reflect on that literature, and share knowledge with their peers. The presentations are oral and will be scheduled in class over the rest of the semester; on Wednesday, September 6, 2006; students will be given their choice of a series of dates for their presentation. Wednesday, November 15th, will be the last night for student presentations.

Students should prepare for their presentations by selecting an article, having that article approved for presentation purposes by the instructor at least two weeks prior to the presentation, and by providing copies of the article for all members of the class. Students who need equipment, from VCRs to internet hook-ups, must make their request to the instructor a week in advance.

The presentation should be approximately 20 minutes in length with a period following for questions.
